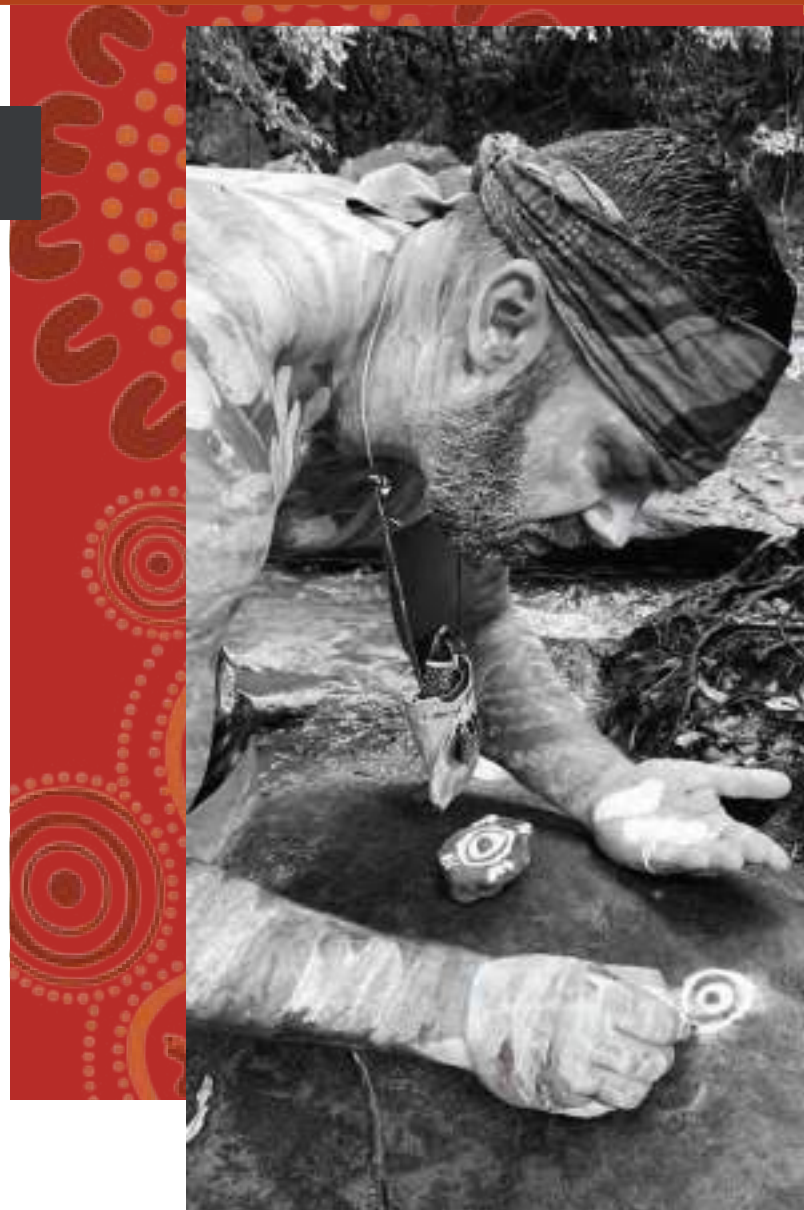
WHAT WE STAND FOR

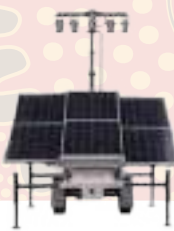

- Providing ongoing training to employees and contractors on all our equipment.
- Constantly revising and updating our health and safety procedures to ensure they are up-to-date and are adhered to.

MAJOR PROJECTS



WESTERN SYDNEY AIRPORT DECEMBER 2023 - SEPTEMBER 2024 SYDNEY, NEW SOUTH WALES

The long-awaited Western Sydney Airport project will be developed over the next 20 years to include multiple runways and terminals for the growing demand for passenger and freight services in Western Sydney. Headed up by Multiplex, this significant infrastructure project is supported by the largest construction businesses nationally.

The new Western Sydney Airport will open in late 2026 and will feature a passenger terminal, a single runway, cargo facilities, maintenance areas, ground transportation options, car parks, and supporting infrastructure. Subsequent stages of development include the addition of multiple runways and terminals.

Access Indigenous is supplying access equipment hire to Austral Interiors as part of major conduct commercial fit-outs for the new airport terminals, ceilings and facades.

DEFENCE BASE WORKS MAY 2024 - DECEMBER 2024 ORCHARD HILLS, NEW SOUTH WALES

The Australian Department of Defence leads this project, which involves major renovations to several buildings at the Orchard Hills base in New South Wales. This includes replacing ageing plant items and buildings, such as offices, warehouses, and testing facilities.

Access Indigenous has partnered with Ghella to supply access equipment for the capital work upgrades to the existing buildings on the base.

PILBARA MINES JUNE 2022 - ONGOING PILBARA REGION, WESTERN AUSTRALIA

This project is headed by Select Plant, a wholly owned subsidiary of construction and engineering company, Laing O'Rourke.

As one of Select's preferred access equipment suppliers, Access Indigenous provides access equipment hire across all their mine site projects and installations, as well as rail infrastructure maintenance in metro locations.

Our equipment is planned to be used across major mining and rail projects nationwide on a ongoing basis.

SYDNEY METRO WEST TUNNEL MARCH 2023 - MARCH 2026 SYDNEY, NEW SOUTH WALES

With completion expected in 2026, the Sydney Metro West project involves constructing a new 24km underground metro railway. The project aims to establish a faster commute between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, forming part of the major upgrades to rail infrastructure throughout the western suburbs.

Access Indigenous joined the project to supply the access equipment needed for the Western Tunnelling contract, which includes 9 km of tunnels from Sydney Olympic Park to Westmead.

The scope of work also includes the supply of equipment to assist in the development of retaining structures, earthworks, and the utility corridor for the Clyde stabling and maintenance facility.
